-This Greek word for image (E-kone) is sometimes **a diminutive form** of another Greek word (E-kone-ion) **meaning portrait.**

Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God:

But made himself of no reputation, and took upon him the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men:

PHILIPPIANS 2:8

And being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.

HEBREWS 2:14

Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;

HEBREWS 2:15

And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

HEBREWS 2:16

For verily he took not on him the nature of angels; but he took on him the seed of Abraham.

HEBREWS 2:17

Wherefore in all things it behoved him to be made like unto his brethren, that he might be a merciful and faithful high priest in things pertaining to God, to make reconciliation for the sins of the people.

HEBREWS 2:18

For in that he himself hath suffered being tempted, he is able to succour them that are tempted.

-The Greek word for "tempted" (pei-raz-o)

LUKE 1:38

"Behold the handmaid of the Lord; be it unto me according to thy word."

Now do you see why it had to be shepherds? Why shepherds? Theologians wouldn't receive It. ...They were shepherds, they knowed sheep; and that's what He was borned, a sheep, a lamb.
