And any man that believes God and takes Him at His Word, **no matter what the situation is, God will perform another paradox,** to keep His Word. For, Abraham called the place Jehovah-jireh, "the Lord has provided for Himself a sacrifice." **He still can cause a paradox to happen.**

EXODUS 14:13

And **Moses said** unto the people, **Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD,** which he will shew to you to day: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen to day, ye shall see them again no more for ever.

EXODUS 14:14

The LORD shall fight for you, and ye shall hold your peace.

EXODUS 14:27

But the children of Israel walked upon dry land in the midst of the sea; and the waters were a wall unto them on their right hand, and on their left.

LUKE 9:62

And Jesus said unto him, No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God.

EXODUS 15:1

Then sang Moses and the children of Israel this song unto the LORD, and spake, saying, I will sing unto the LORD, for he hath triumphed gloriously: the horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea.

EXODUS 15:4

Pharaoh's chariots and his host hath he cast into the sea: his chosen captains also are drowned in the Red sea.

GENESIS 12:1

Now the LORD had said unto Abram, Get thee out of thy country, and from thy kindred, and from thy father's house, unto a land that I will shew thee:

EXODUS 15:11

Who is like unto thee, O LORD, among the gods? who is like thee, glorious in holiness, fearful in praises, **doing wonders?**

The word "wonders" (Heb., "pele") means "**the extraordinary, a miracle or something marvelous.**"

EXODUS 15:14

The people **shall hear,** and be afraid: sorrow shall take hold on the inhabitants of Palestina.

EXODUS 15:15

Then the dukes of Edom **shall be amazed**; the mighty men of Moab, trembling shall take hold upon them; all the inhabitants of Canaan shall melt away.

MARK 5:19

Howbeit Jesus suffered him not, but saith unto him, **Go home to thy friends,** and **tell them how great things the Lord hath done for thee,** and hath had compassion on thee.
