Vs.7

Ye offer polluted bread upon mine altar; and ye say, Wherein have we polluted thee? In that ye say, The table of the LORD is contemptible. (Scorn, Despised, Ed)

Vs.8

And if ye offer the blind for sacrifice, is it not evil? and if ye offer the lame and sick, is it not evil? offer it now unto thy governor; will he be pleased with thee, or accept thy person? saith the LORD of hosts.

Vs.9

And now, I pray you, beseech God that he will be gracious unto us: this hath been by your means: will he regard your persons? saith the LORD of hosts.

Vs.10

Who is there even among you that would shut the doors for nought? neither do ye kindle fire on mine altar for nought. I have no pleasure in you, saith the LORD of hosts, neither will I accept an offering at your hand.

Vs.11

For from the rising of the sun even unto the going down of the same my name shall be great among the Gentiles; and in every place incense shall be offered unto my name, and a pure offering: for my name shall be great among the heathen, saith the LORD of hosts.

Vs.12

But <u>ye have profaned it</u>, in that ye say, <u>The table of the LORD is polluted; and the fruit thereof, even his meat, is contemptible.</u>

Vs.13

Ye said also, **Behold, what a weariness is it!** and **ye have snuffed at it**, saith the LORD of hosts; and **ye brought that which was torn, and the lame, and the sick**; thus ye brought an offering: should I accept this of your hand? saith the LORD.

Vs.14

But <u>cursed be the deceiver</u>, which hath in his flock a male, and <u>voweth</u>, and <u>sacrificeth unto the Lord a corrupt thing</u>: for <u>I am a great King</u>, saith the LORD of hosts, and my name is dreadful among the heathen.

EZRA 3:1-6

Vs.1

And when the seventh month was come, and the children of Israel were in the cities, the people gathered themselves together as one man to Jerusalem.

Vs.2

Then stood up Jeshua the son of Jozadak, and his brethren the priests, and Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and his brethren, and builded the altar of the God of Israel, to offer burnt offerings thereon, as it is written in the law of Moses the man of God.

Vs.3

And they set the altar upon his bases; for fear was upon them because of the people of those countries: and they offered burnt offerings thereon unto the LORD, even burnt offerings morning and evening.

Vs.4

They kept also the feast of tabernacles, as it is written, and offered the daily burnt offerings by number, according to the custom, **as the duty of every day required**;

Vs.5

And afterward offered the continual burnt offering, both of the new moons, and of all the set feasts of the LORD that were consecrated, **and of every one that willingly** offered a freewill offering unto the LORD.

Vs.6

From the first day of the seventh month began they to offer burnt offerings unto the LORD. But the foundation of the temple of the LORD was not yet laid.

EZRA 3:11

And they sang together by course in praising and giving thanks unto the LORD; because he is good, for his mercy endureth for ever toward Israel. And all the people shouted with a great shout, when they praised the LORD, because the foundation of the house of the LORD was laid.

JUDE 1:20
